- ___ Students should not be in possession of alcohol / alcoholic beverages at any time in accordance with District Rules
- ___ Students should not be in possession of cigarettes/smoking paraphernalia at any time in accordance with District Rules
- ___ Students will receive wake-up calls each morning TBD by the Lead Chaperone and expected to be prompt
- ___ Students should never leave with anyone who is not participating in the service trip
- ___ Students should meet all students and encourage collaboration
- ___ Students should contact their chaperone immediately concerning any rule violation

* Emergency Medical cards and liability release information signatures must be on file with all chaperones prior to departure. Any injury will be reported to the parent immediately.
